

Dabur Oncquest plans more centres

DABUR ONCQUEST, one of the leaders in cancer diagnosis, is planning to expand its collection centres in the country. Addressing a Press conference on Thursday, head of diagnostics Dabur Pharma Ltd Vivek Trikha said the unique concept of providing all tests under one roof had proved vital to doctors and was cost-effective as well. He said, "Presently, we have 35 centres in the country and the number would be increased soon. Trikha said some of the tests provided by Dabur Onc-Quest were not available in the US too since the technology was first brought to India. "We are looking to add some more tests for better diagnosis. The company first wants to re-engineer the tests to make it convenient for Indians to afford," Trikha said.
